I found the specials to be some of the chef's best creations. The Napoleon of smoked salmon tartare and dill marscarpone cream was a triangular work of art as well as a delicious appetizer. The tuna tartare with pears, wasabi and sesame seed, finished with a lemon crème fraiche, was just as mouthwatering as the Ahi Tuna Tar Tar I tasted during my fall visit. I also enjoyed the Grilled Washington State Black Angus Steak, which was complemented nicely by a Swiss cheese tart and finished with a Dijon-horseradish sauce.
